- Week 20: Unshaken by Conflict

Section 1 - The Good Days of David: God raised David to be the undisputed king over Israel, yet there were seeds of sin that began flowering.

Section 2 - The Dark Days of David: David allowed his sin to fester, which led to the destruction of the people around him. Yet through it, he grew in his faith.

Section 3 - Descent to Death

Week 20:

Scripture Focus: 2 Samuel 20:1-21:22

v.20:1-26

Conflict 1: David continued to have rebels within the Israelite people.

v.21:1-14

Conflict 2: David had to deal with the sins of Saul.

v.21:15-26

Conflict 3: David had enemies on his borders.

David continued to experience not only the repercussions of his own sin, but the sins of others. Yet he learned to find his refuge in the Lord.

Scripture Reference: Psalms 16:1-11

God calls us into his refuge, not just for conflicts we cause, but for the conflicts brought on by others.
