- Week 14: Reconciliation in God's Timing

Week 7-13: God calls us to not allow sin to fester, because it will grow and destroy as much as it can.

Week 14:

Scripture Focus: 2 **Samuel** 14:1-15:12

v.14:1-28

Joab tries to play **God** to bring Absalom **back** to Israel, even though **God hadn't** called for it.

v.29-33

Absalom shows that he **isn't** above causing **chaos** to get **his** way.

v.15:1-12

Absalom sows **seeds** of **distrust** among the people, and creates a **conspiracy** to **overthrow** his father.

Too often we try to **play** the part of **God** and **force relationships** that **shouldn't** happen.

We **should** desire **reconciliation**, but our **desire** should be **directed** by **God**.

Scripture Reference: **Psalms** 37:3-7a

Challenge:

Seek God daily in praying for a relationship you know needs reconciliation. Pray that the reconciliation would be in God's timing, not forced, but it comes by way of repentance.
