Week 10: The **theological** aspect of **giving**, is **rooted** in God’s **love** for us, through the **work** of Jesus’ **incarnation**.

Week 11: We are to have **faithful character**, where **giving** becomes an **extension** of that character in **physical** means.

Week 12:

Scripture Focus: 2nd **Corinthians** 9:6-15

v.1

The **amount** given is not in **focus**, but rather the **portion** of **blessing** based on the gift.

CAUTION: This **isn’t** a **call** to **give more** to **get more**, as **false** teachers will **proclaim**.

v.7

Our **giving** is **based** on our **relationship** with **God**, rather than on a **fixed** amount.

v.8-9

Paul brings our **attention** back to **God’s giving**, that we might remember that key **theological** aspect.

v.10-12

When we **give**, we must remember that God is **faithful** in **blessing**, but his **blessing** is with the **kingdom** in focus, not our **wallets**.

Scripture Reference: **Matthew** 6:25-33

God is calling us to **kingdom** work in our **giving**, where it isn’t the **monetary** return, but the **soul** in **eternity** that is at **stake**.

Evaluate your giving in light of Kingdom work.
