## Pastor's Corner

In October of 2020, the Alliance released a song called, "All of Jesus (For All the World)"

The lyrics are:

**Lord, awake your sleeping  
bride, light again the fire inside,  
shatter all the things that blind us  
to your call ...**

**May all hands no more  
withhold, perfect love that we**

**behold, may it go beyond the comfort of our walls ... All of Jesus, All of  
Jesus, All of Jesus for all the world ... Cause our feet to venture forward,  
to the nation's farthest shore, bring them out of darkness, to the Father's  
arm ... All of Jesus, All of Jesus, All of Jesus, for all the world.**

It's a simple song to call the Church to its purpose. We do not share a half Gospel; a hope that is incomplete of its full meaning. We are to proclaim the fullness of Jesus, which includes the bad news of sin, and goodness of his salvation. The Gospel is truly goodness only when understood against the bad news. Bad news: each of us is on a path to destruction for our participation in the evil of rebelling against God, which is called sin. This rebellion happens every time we defile a relationship through gossip, adultery, lying, stealing, disrespect, holding anger, or not forgiving. That path of destruction is an eternal state of separation from all that we find good in this world, because all that we experience that is good, is given to us by the grace of God. Yet that grace will be removed for those on the path of destruction, and that is the true judgment.

If this was the only news it would be a half Gospel, but the Gospel has with it the good news. The Good news is Jesus has come to die to set us on a new path of life. He took the punishment and judgment that was earned by us, and transfers our

debt to himself that we may live a life fully in God's grace.

A Gospel without the good is only half, but a Gospel with only the good is also half. Good News: God wants goodness for our lives, this is true, but we must submit to him, repent and take on Christ to cover us. There is no good news without an acknowledgment of the bad, and a turning away from it.

Let's not present a half-Gospel to the world, that only eases momentary suffering. For if we halve the Gospel, we do a disservice to all that would hear it, giving them a half hope, that will end in ruin. Let us awake and arise to our call to bring all of Jesus to all the world, until the day when all the world, sees all of Jesus. Amen!


