- Week 10: Good from the Tornado

Week 7: God uses **extreme** language to call us **away** from **sin**, so that we **understand** that sin is **not** something to **play** with.

Week 8: God will not **allow** sin in our lives to go **unpunished**, and will **expose** sin **publicly** if necessary.

Week 9: God is calling us to a **Psalms 51** attitude of **confession**, **repentance** and **cleansing** so that we would bring **right sacrifices** to him.

Week 10: God is calling us to view sin as it is, an **unfair wicked** thing that needs to be **repented** of.

Week 11:

Scripture Focus: 2 **Samuel** 12:24-31

v.24-25

God **limits** his **judgment**, and by doing so, shows that he is both **good** and **just**.

v.26-31

God gives a **temporary reprieve** from judgment to show his **love** for David.

A **central** point to God's **love** is, though we might do **evil**, God's **intention** is **always** to bring about his **goodness**.

God **desires** us to experience his **good** things, but those **good** things **only** come through **following** him.

Challenge:

If you're going through something hard, seek him in forgiveness when needed, and praise God with the anticipation that he is bringing good out of it. If things are good, praise God for his good gifts.
